Student Parking Lot Rules 2017-2018

- Your permit must always be displayed from your rear-view mirror print side facing out the front windshield.
- The Houston County Board of Education is not responsible for losses of or damages, including bodily injury, to the property of users of its facilities.
- The school administration reserves the right to suspend or revoke parking privileges without a refund for the cost of a permit.
- While on campus, your vehicle is subject to searches at any time.
- Parking permits cost \$30.00 until April 2, 2018 when the cost of a permit becomes \$15.00. (**Replacing a lost tag is \$1.00**).
- When you arrive at the school, park your vehicle and go directly into the school building. When you have been dismissed for the day, you must leave the parking lot immediately.
- Students are not allowed to ride in the back of a pickup truck or the outside of any other vehicle except a motorcycle.
- Report all accidents to the front office immediately.
- If your privileges are revoked during the fall semester, you may purchase a new parking permit, if available, or put your name on the waiting list, when the spring semester begins.
- On-campus student parking is a privilege provided by Veterans High School.
 Violations of parking lot rules may result in your vehicle being booted/towed or your permit being suspended or revoked.

Some infractions that may result in the loss of your parking privilege, fines, or further disciplinary actions include, but are not limited to:

- Parking without a parking permit
- Parking in the wrong location. PARK <u>ONLY</u> IN YOUR ASSIGNED NUMBERED SPACE.
- Going to the parking lot during the school day without permission from an administrator
- Leaving campus without permission
- Violating any Houston County School System rules regarding alcohol, drugs of weapons
- Violating any rules applicable to Georgia highways
