The 1st Place Winner of the Rotary Club of Warner Robins Speech Contest will advance to the Western District Speech Contest. The District Contest will be held on April 7th at Middle Georgia State University’s campus in Warner Robins. The contestant will compete against other local club winners within the Western District. The winner at the District Speech Contest will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship. This student must be able to present their speech at the District 6920 All Club Celebration that is held April 27-29, 2018 at Jekyll Island in order to receive their scholarship. All high school students are eligible if they attend the following high schools: Warner Robins, Northside, Houston County and Veterans.

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. Limited use of 3x5 note cards are allowed but not preferred.
2. Duration of the speech is expected to be a min of 3 minutes but no more than 4 minutes.
3. Professional attire is expected and consider part of scoring
