SUBJECT: Annual Call for Scholarship Nominations (Suspense: 01 February 2018)

1. For more than twenty years, the American Society of Military Comptrollers (ASMC) Middle Georgia Chapter has awarded college scholarships to one or more high school seniors who plan to pursue a degree in the financial management field. This year, we will have two scholarships available, the Clyde O. Bloodworth Distinguished Scholarship for \$1,000 and the Meritorious Scholarship for \$1,000.
2. Students wishing to compete for these scholarships must have a 3.00 GPA, be accepted or enrolled at an accredited college, and be entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management (e.g. accounting, finance, economics, or business). Selection will be based on scholastic achievement, demonstrated leadership, extracurricular activities, financial need and educational/career goals as well as letters of recommendation. Applications of chosen winners will also be submitted to the ASMC national scholarship program for nine additional scholarships.
3. Interested students need to complete and return the attached application along with two letters of recommendation; one from either your high school principal or guidance counselor and the other from a high school teacher. A copy of your college acceptance letter also needs to be included with your submission.
