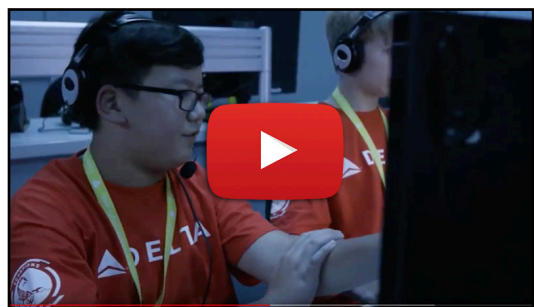
Delta Air Lines is providing tuition scholarships to 80 students of military dependents to attend a six-day, five-night immersive program at the National Flight Academy! This amazing opportunity is only available to military dependents.

The National Flight Academy is a premier Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (or STEM) education institution that provides students in grades 7-12 with a fully-immersive, learning adventure of a lifetime! During the NFA's 6-day overnight program, 7-12 grade students live aboard AMBITION, a state-of-the-art virtual aircraft carrier. They work together to plan humanitarian missions with ultramodern, advanced technology, learn to fly in 42 networked flight simulators, eat on a mess deck, sleep in staterooms and receive mission briefings in six fully electronic ready rooms. By working in a team squadron format, they can collaborate and complete missions using a variety of STEM-based concepts while facilitators and chiefs (program counselors) incorporate 21st Century Core Competency Skills like leadership, communication, and critical thinking.

Tuition scholarships are valued at \$1,250 each. Delta does NOT cover travel to and from the National Flight Academy in Pensacola, FL. However shuttle service is provided from Pensacola International Airport to the NFA for those students traveling by air.

### HOW TO WIN A SCHOLARSHIP

Children must compete for a scholarship seat via a Video or Essay Submission. They are required to submit video or essay; see details listed to the right. Winning students will receive a scholarship to the National Flight Academy!



### REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must be between 11-17 years-old
- Applicants must be preparing to enter grades 7-12.
- Applicants must be a military dependent

### VIDEO CONTEST OPTION:

- Video needs to stay within 1 to 1 1/2 minutes long
- Applicants must upload video on their own YouTube Channel
- Video must feature the child's OWN work! Judging will be based on effort, originality, creativity, and understanding of STEM concepts.

### ESSAY CONTEST OPTION:

- To the best of the student's ability, write a 500-word essay (450 - 550 words are acceptable, if the topic is covered)
- Essay must be typed in a word processor, then copy and paste it into the corresponding text box.
- Essay should represent the child's OWN work.

### VIDEO OR ESSAY MUST ANSWER ONE OF THE FOLLOWING PROMPTS:

1. How would you use Science, Technology, Engineering and Math to be a positive influence on the world? Please include why you would want to attend the National Flight Academy.
2. How do you think the aviation industry will use Science, Technology, Engineering and Math concepts to make significant advances to aviation over the next 50 years? Please include why you would want to attend the National Flight Academy.

### SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Video & Essay Submission Deadline: Parents must submit their child's video or essay through this portal <https://tinyurl.com/ybrzhba3> by Friday, March 8, 2019 @ 11:59 pm CST. Any videos or essays submitted after this deadline will not be considered.
