HOPE SCHOLARSHIP RIGOR REQUIREMENTS

New academic requirements are included in the HOPE legislation. These changes will impact students graduating on or after May 1, 2015. In order to qualify for the HOPE Scholarship on or after May 1, 2017, students must receive <u>4</u> credits in the following type courses:

- 1. Advanced math, such as Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, or an equivalent or higher course.
- 2. Advanced science, such as Chemistry, Physics, or an equivalent or higher course.
- 3. Advanced Placement courses in core* subjects.
- 4. International Baccalaureate courses in core* subjects.
- 5. Courses taken at an institution of the University System of Georgia in core* subjects that are not remedial or developmental courses.
- 6. Advanced foreign language courses.
