He believed that participation in sports along with a strive for academic excellence helped to build a strong mind, character, and discipline.

In 2019, the scholarship will provide two (2) awards of \$750 each to high school seniors in Warner Robins, GA, who participated in varsity high school sports and plan to participate at the collegiate level.

### Eligibility:

Applicants to the Lorrie Owens Memorial Foundation Scholarship must meet the following requirements:

- Resident of Warner Robins, GA
- Graduating high school senior who plans to enroll in a full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university for the 2019-2020 academic year
- Minimum high school GPA of 2.0 is required
- High School Varsity sports participation
- Planned participation at collegiate level

### Awards:

Two (2) awards of \$750 each will be made to graduating seniors in Warner Robins, Georgia.

### Application Process:

- Complete the application and respond to one (1) short essay question.
- All questions must be answered. Please use N/A to indicate answers unable to be completed. Incomplete applications will not receive further consideration.
- Applications must be typed/computer generated.
- Provide proof of high school GPA signed by high school counselor.
- Provide proof of college acceptance.
- Provide proof of plan to participate in a sport at the collegiate level.
