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## SUMMER SCHOOL STUDENT RULES & GUIDELINES SUMMER 2017

SUBJECT: Student Discipline/Time Requirement Agreement

We would like to welcome you to summer school at Warner Robins Middle School. Our goal is to provide you the opportunity for promotion to the next grade. The middle school guidelines we follow during the regular school year will also apply during summer school. Summer school affords students the opportunity to pass the subject area(s) necessary for promotion to the next grade. Summer school is different in that it is not required. Students may attend summer school provided they do not hinder the teacher's ability to teach. Students missing more than four (4) full class dates will not receive credit and will forfeit their tuition.

**First day of class:** Monday, June 5, 2017

**Progress Reports:** Friday, June 16, 2017

**Last day of class:** Friday, June 30, 2017

**Class Time:** AM Session - 7:30am - 10:40am PM Session - 11:00am – 2:10pm

**Make-up Time:** Make-up time will start on June 19 at \$3.00 per hour or any part of an hour. Tardies to class must be made up at the same rate as missed class time. It is the student's responsibility to make up missed time. If a student takes two (2) classes, he/she must make up missed time after the regular session ends at 2:10pm. Students taking only one (1) class have the option of staying after school or during the other class session time. Please see below for make-up times:

June 19-30 from 8:00am- 11:00pm and/or 2:00pm- 3:30pm

All make-up time must be completed and paid for by June 30 in order for a student to receive credit.

**Free Breakfast & Lunch:** We will provide a breakfast and lunch to students. The breakfast will be served each day from 7:10- 7:30am. The lunch will be served each day from 10:40- 11:00am.

**Discipline Policy:** Students will be given one office referral for minor offenses; parents and students will be informed. A second referral may result in withdrawal from summer school. A major offense will result in immediate withdrawal from summer school and forfeit of tuition. **There will be no refund of tuition for disciplinary withdrawals.**

**Dress Code:** The HCBE dress code for the regular school year will be followed during summer school. Refusal to follow the dress code will be treated as a discipline issue.

**Campus & Building Cleanliness:** We are proud of our neat and clean campus and building. Each student will clean up behind him or herself in the lunchroom and classroom each day. Any type of vandalism will result in withdrawal from summer school, discipline, and a police report.

**Textbooks:** Students are responsible for any textbooks issued to them. Money due for a lost or damaged textbook must be paid prior to the end of summer school.

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### **PROMPT PICK-UP EACH DAY**

Your child must be picked up promptly each day. We do not have the personnel to wait for late pick-ups. Please make sure your pick-up is on time. Otherwise, the student will be dismissed without a refund of tuition. Walkers will leave from the front of the school. Drop-off and pick-up will always take place on the bus ramp side of the school.

**Transportation to and from Perry Middle School:** Bus transportation will be provided from PMS for students from South Houston County. The bus will leave the PMS bus ramp at 6:45am and return at 2:40pm each day. Students that take only one class during the AM session will be transported back to Perry following the afternoon session, or parents must drop off and/or pick up daily. Misbehavior and/or disrespect to the driver or monitor will result in a suspension from riding the bus.

Each session lasts for 180 instructional minutes. Students will have a 10 minute break during each session. Breakfast & lunch will be provided.

### COST:

### REGISTRATION:

All tuition must be paid at registration. Cash or money orders only (no checks will be accepted).

### ITEMS NEEDED:

To register, students will need a completed registration form signed by a parent/guardian, their latest report card, and the full amount of tuition money in cash or money order.

### TRANSPORTATION:

If needed, for students from South Houston County, a bus will leave Perry Middle School's bus ramp at 6:45am and return at 2:40pm each day. Otherwise, all students must have plans to be dropped off and picked up timely each day.
