Temperature – the measure of how hot or cold something is.

Thermal energy – the form of energy that moves particles of matter.

Solar energy – thermal energy that moves from the sun to the earth.

Heat – the movement of thermal energy from hotter to colder things.

Thermometer – A tool used to measure temperature.

Celsius – metric scale for measuring temperature (0 freezing & 100 boiling point).

Fahrenheit – standard scale for measuring temperature (32 freezing & 212 boiling point).

Thermostat – a device that turns heating, cooling, and other appliances on or off.
