2016-2017 Credit Recovery Program
Student Registration Form

MP will be offering an eight week session of credit recovery this semester. **The session will begin September 12th and run until November 10th.** Students will be able to earn a ½ unit for each class. Students must complete all course work with a 70% or better in the assigned session in order to receive credit. Students must pay \$50.00 for each ½ unit class. Full payment is due at the time of registration. Please return registration forms to the Graduation Coach office.

Classes are scheduled Monday-Thursday from 3:15 - 5:15. All sessions will be held in Room 228.

Credit recovery will be conducted through a computer-based program, Edgenuity. Students will be required to complete all course work on the computer with the assistance of a facilitator. Students must abide by all the policies listed below in order to participate in the credit recovery program:

1. Students must finish all work within the time allotted.
2. Students may not miss more than **three days of after-school or one day of Saturday school.** Students must provide a note explaining any absence or parents can call the school at 478-994-2812 to report their child's absence for the day.
3. Students may access the site from home but must take ALL tests in the presence of the classroom facilitators.
4. Students are not required to report once their course has been successfully completed and a passing score has been obtained, however, if a student is taking a course that requires an End of Course test, the student must take the test on the scheduled date(s).
5. Students must comply with the rules and regulations of the school as printed in the 2015-2016 MPHS Student Handbook. Failure to comply with these rules can result in the removal from the class. Refunds will not be given to students who are removed from class.

Students enrolled in the *second semester* of Ninth Grade Literature, American Literature, Physical Science, Biology, American History, and/or Economics must take the GA Milestone End of Course Test. Grading policies are as follows:

1. The EOC will count 20% of the student's overall average, students must take this test in order to receive credit for the course.
2. The EOC will be administered at MPHS for credit recovery students upon completion of their course.

Due to limited seating, registration will be granted on a first come-first serve basis.
