

All teachers (including non-homeroom) need to have their posters in place by the end of the work day on Tuesday, October 13th or Wednesday morning at the latest!

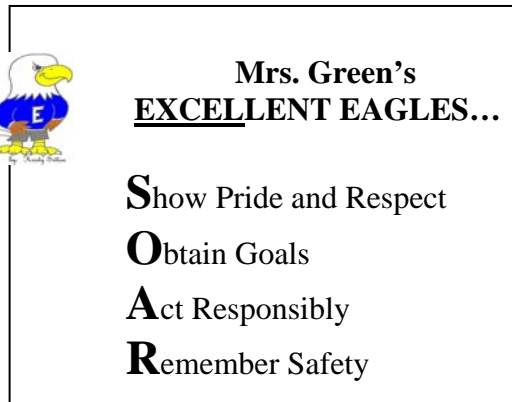

#1: SOAR Poster:

*******DON'T FORGET ABOUT ETON'S POSTER MAKER!!!!**

~Display SOAR expectations on a piece of poster board. Most of you have a cute little ditty already regarding your specific classrooms that you can include on your poster, i.e., "Oliver's Owls SOAR". We are the Eagles, but you could use a different "granimal" that relates to your "nickname". Just be sure it includes the SOAR information. These need to be laminated and placed somewhere around the OUTSIDE of your door.

EXAMPLE



#2: Classroom Behavior Poster:

~Display your classroom behaviors on a piece of poster board INSIDE your room. The behaviors must relate to the SOAR expectations. Your poster should include bullets that explain what the rules of the classroom are in relation to SOAR. We can teach the rules if we show what is expected and start rewarding behaviors that are appropriate.

Our Classroom Rules

Be Respectful and Show Pride

- Be kind to others.
- Always use appropriate language.
- Respect the property of others and their right to learn.
- Follow the rules set by the classroom teacher.

Be Responsible

- Follow school dress code.
- Have required class supplies and assignments.
- Always give your best effort and be ready to learn.

Be Safe

- Walk into the room and sit in assigned seat before the tardy bell rings.
- Consume food and beverages during scheduled breaks. (Chewing gum is not permitted.)
