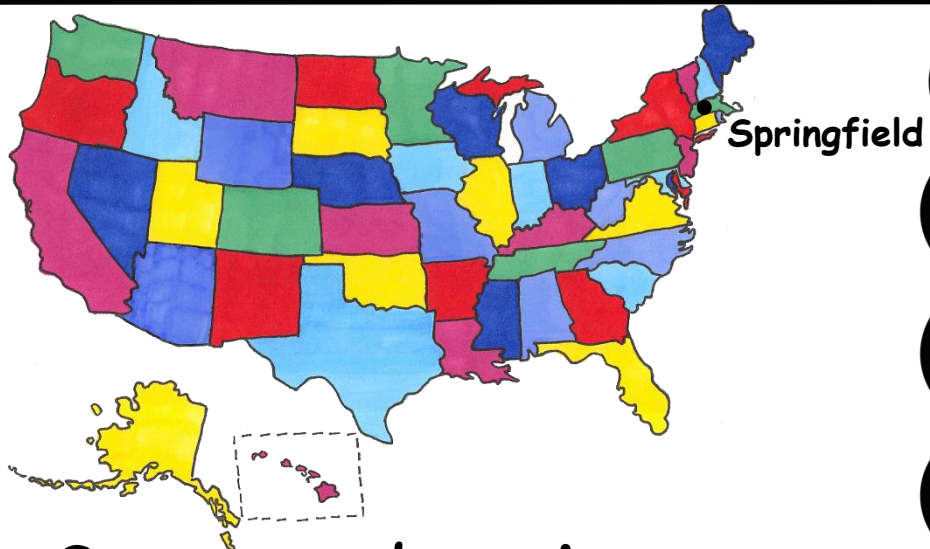
# The Life of Dr. Seuss



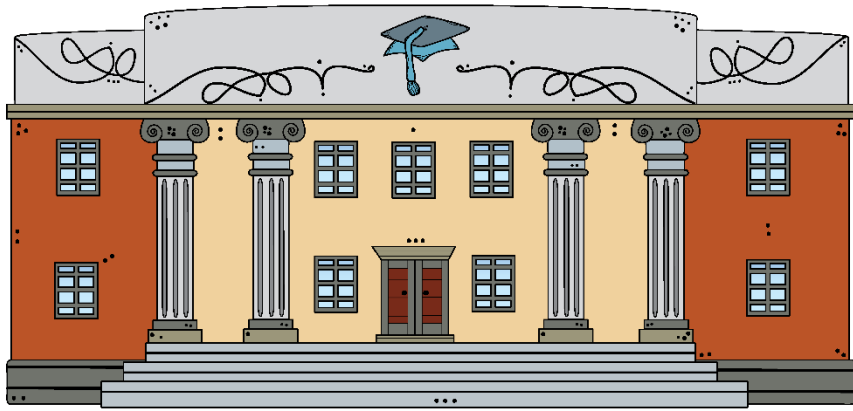
His full name is Theodor Seuss Geisel, but his family called him Ted.

2, 1904.



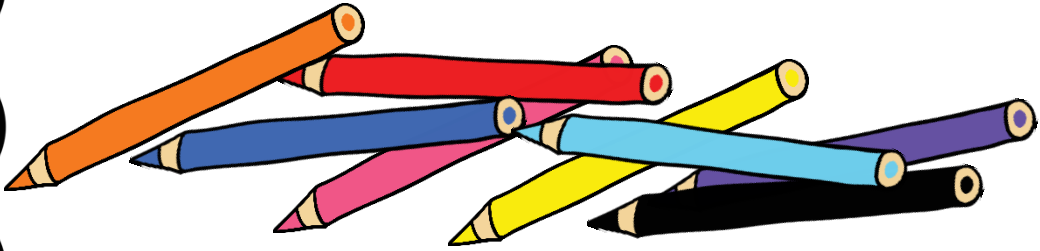
Dr. Seuss was born in

In 1927, Dr. Seuss married Helen Palmer.



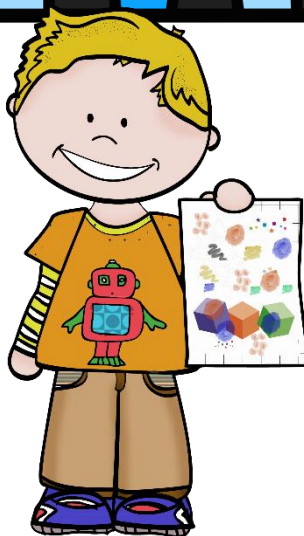
Dr. Seuss loved to draw.



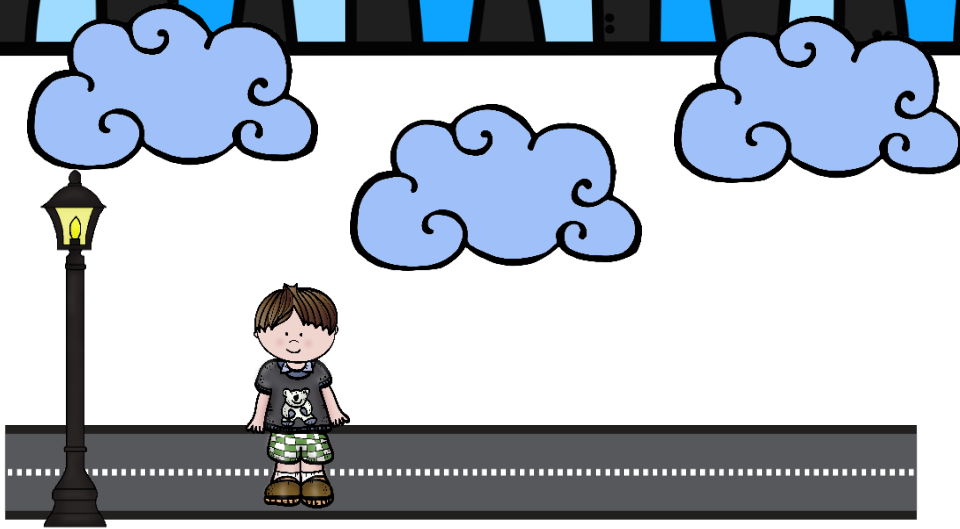
Dr. Seuss also loved to rhyme.



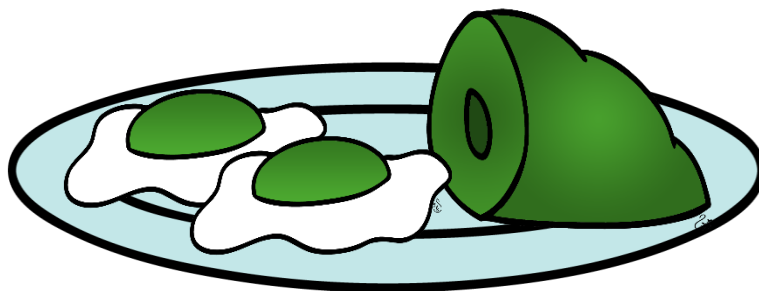
Dr. Seuss decided to be an author.



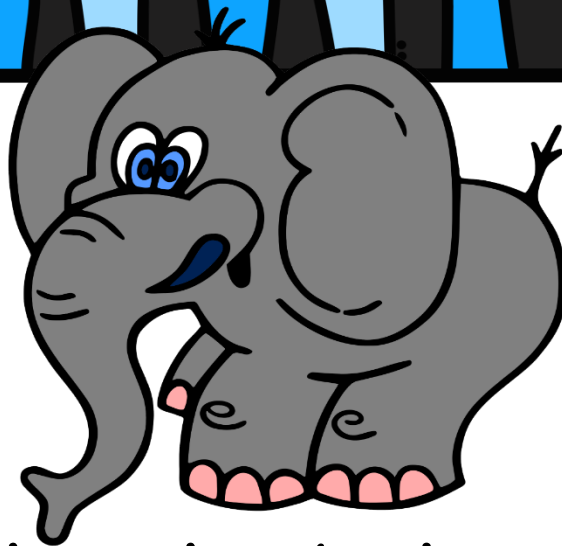
Dr. Seuss also decided to be an illustrator.

and "Horton Hears a Who!"

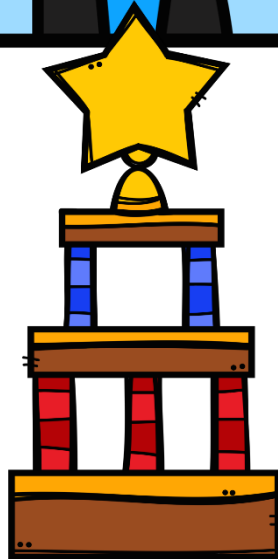


Dr. Seuss has published more  
than 60 books.





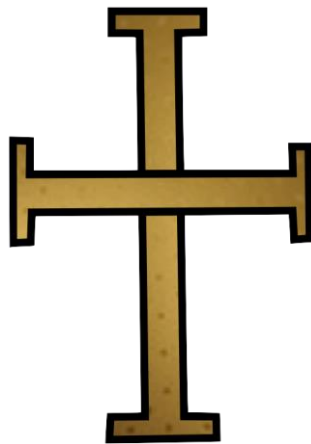
Many of his characters have been given life in movies.

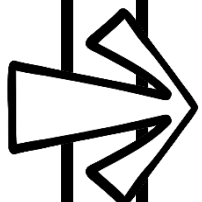

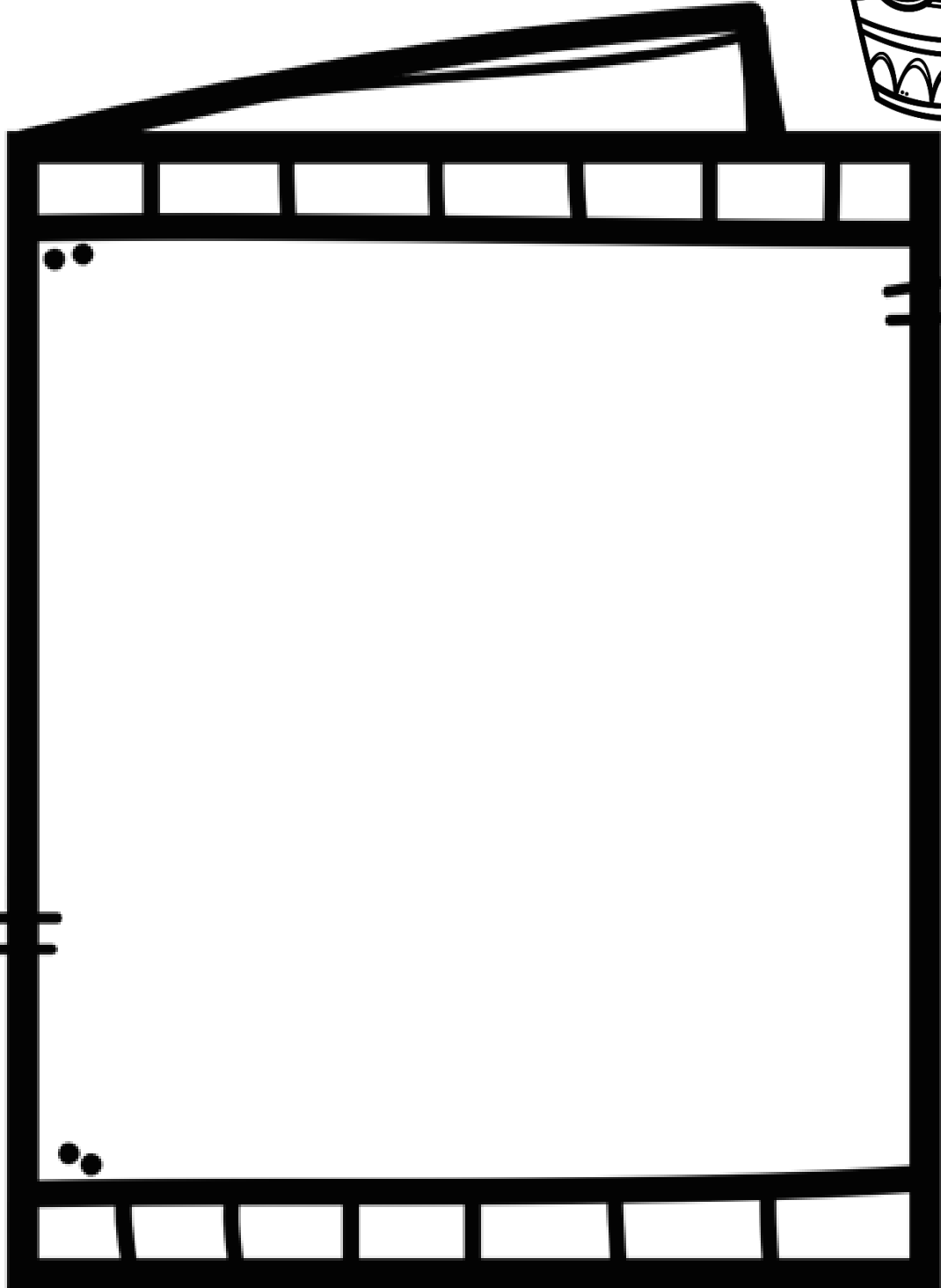
