Pick 1 of the activities below to use with your vocabulary words. Make sure to show your understanding of the words.

Write a short story using all of the vocabulary words correctly. Underline your words in the story	Draw a detailed, colored picture of you doing one of your favorite activities. Disguise your vocabulary words in the picture. Create a list of hints for the words you put in your picture.	Create a crossword puzzle using all of the vocabulary words. Be sure to write clues AND draw the puzzle for all of your words.
Develop a game using the vocabulary words, definitions and examples.	For each of the words draw a picture that illustrates the meaning of the word.	Find your vocabulary words in real-life such as in a newspaper, a magazine, or on a cereal box. Cut out the word and paste onto a piece of paper. Explain where you found the words and how they were used.
Create a word search using all of the vocabulary words. Do not include a list of words, instead include hints or definitions of the words in the puzzle.	Write each of the vocabulary words. Describe each one and find 2 examples of each.	Create a cartoon strip using all of the vocabulary words in the conversations between the characters.
Make a concentration/memory game with all of the words (write the word on one card and the definition on another - repeat for all words). Scramble the cards, place them face down, and then try to make matches.	Use your vocabulary words and definitions to create cards for a Go Fish game.	Make a Pictionary flashcard game. Draw a picture of the word on one side and put the word and definition on the back.
