- I. District and School Continuous Improvement Update
- II. Discussed SACS and how it is operated and the importance of it. (Advance Ed- Report)
  - a. Discussed school improvement plan.
  - b. Visible learning (Things you should see when you walk into a classroom.) It should increase student achievement.
  - c. Discussed formative and summative assessments. Formative is the done in the middle of a lesson (Check for learning). Summative are done at the end of the year. i.e. (Georgia Milestone Tests.)
  - d. Data Exit ticket/Benchmark/Fidelity. All leads into continuous improvement. Implement with Fidelity, i.e. a jump.
  - e. SACS will be back to see how we have implement improvement priorities. Take away accreditation.
- III. CAN (Comprehensive Needs Assessment)
  - a. School Improvement Process. (Wanted it to be known because we may be surveyed. It integrates what's from SACS.
  - b. Discussed Georgia Milestone Results (Preliminary Results are lower than previous scores) had meetings with parents about Lexile scores.
    - There was a slight increase in performance, but the overall average is down.
    - Students who are reading at or above grade level at a 25% content piece.
- IV. Discussed discipline (PBIS)
  - a. Fighting is our biggest problem, the most behavior problems are on Monday's. And it is either in the classroom or the gym.
  - b. Dr. Willaford said he read an article about discipline, and data is very subjective to say the least.
  - c. Referral process form should be aligned with the current. The idea is to change the culture.

  - c. Talked about curriculum nights, they will be held every 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of every month.
