Annual reports of student achievement are issued each year. In previous years, this report was issued by giving an AYP status for schools. Evaluations are comprised of various criteria including year-to-year student achievement on statewide assessments and graduation rates. The evaluation criteria will include all students as well as many subgroups of students within the school.

Beginning in 2012-2011, Georgia schools were evaluated using the College and Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI) using many differing variable to give a score based on a 1 - 100 scale. The most recent scores are from the 2014 school year. Schley County Middle School received an 89.2 with the State Average being 74.1.
