The kid-friendly math standards documents provide teachers with the "I can" standards which can be printed and posted in the classroom.

"I can" statements:

- are clear statements that identify each goal that is necessary in order to master the standard
- are brief and only contain the goals for one standard or just the components for one single goal
- are written in student-talk rather than educational jargon
- can be used to record student progress

Student Monitoring Sheet documents

Student monitoring sheets for each grade are provided. These sheets are meant to provide a visual for students to record their progress. The monitoring sheets can be reviewed and discussed with students and parents. Each "I can" statement includes a stoplight which can be filled in before, during, or after assessments. Students can use the color green to represent, "Yes! I can do this." Yellow represents, "I am almost there." Red represents, "No, I cannot do this."
