Academic Resources:

Grades K-8

- **Reading and Math I-Ready Online Program Access**
 - Individual schools will provide assistance for students and parents on accessing the online platform

Grades 9-12

- **Course content provided by teachers**
 - Course content packets will also be distributed at each school (see resource distribution below)
- **Online access to courses using Google Classroom, USA Test Prep, Edgenuity, Edmentum (CTAE courses), and My Path.**

Resource Distribution:

Student Activity Packets and Course Content Packets will be distributed at each school from **10:00 am to 1:00 pm on Friday, March 20, 2020**. Academic resources will be distributed in a Drive-Through process. Parents/Guardians will drive up to the school to receive work packets for their child(ren). Precautionary measures will be taken to minimize personal contact. Parents/guardians will not get out of their cars nor come into the school buildings.

Teacher Support:

Teachers will be available to support students and answer questions from both students and parents **Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 3:30 pm** via Class Dojo. Class Dojo is the district's adopted form of communication to parents.
