Choose one (1) project for each novel:

<p>Writing: Write a song, rap, or poem summarizing the events of each chapter. It must relate/describe the plot, characters, setting, theme, etc. of the novel.</p>	<p>Analysis: Create a "Cliff Notes" booklet. Summarize each of the 12 chapters. Give a full character analysis of each of the main characters. Describe 3 different settings.</p>	<p>Book Review: Write a book review. It must be a minimum of three (3) paragraphs. Briefly outline the main characters, setting, plot, and theme. Highlight figurative language, vocabulary words, etc. Also, tell whether you would recommend this novel. Must include an illustration.</p>
<p>Journaling: Keep a diary from a main character's point of view describing the plot, characters, setting, theme, etc. of the novel. This should include her/his thoughts & feelings, actions, and significant events from the entire novel. Minimum of 25 entries. You may create your diary or buy one and write in it. Entries must be a minimum of two (2) paragraphs (6 to 8 sentences).</p>	<p>Analysis: Select a character from the book, then select 10 quotations from the text that you feel reveals the character's personality. You must explain what each quotation tells you about the character. You must also tell which page the quotation/sentence came from. In a couple of paragraphs, briefly highlight the theme, plot, setting, climax, etc.</p>	<p>Writing: Write a new ending for the story, a new adventure for the main character, or the beginning of a sequel. The tone and format should be the same as the original novel. If you get rid of old characters, then tell what happened to them; if you invent new characters, then describe them. This should be at least 800 words.</p>
<p>Comparison: Create a triple Venn Diagram comparing three (3) of the main characters. You must have 8 points of comparison. In addition, you must write a 5-paragraph report of your findings.</p>	<p>Social Media: Create at a minimum of one (1) Instagram post for each chapter from the character of your choosing's point of view. You must include a picture, captions, hashtags, likes, responses, etc. for each post.</p>	<p>Book Report: Highlight the theme, plot, setting, climax, characters, etc. Should be five (5) paragraphs including a rough draft and outline.</p>
