

## Scholars Academy / Thomas University Associate of Arts in Liberal Studies

**Purpose:** To allow students enrolled in the Scholars Academy to earn an associates degree through Thomas University while meeting high school graduation requirements.

## Admission to the program:

- 1. Student must be enrolled as a sophomore at the Scholars Academy and have met the pre-requisites set by the Academy.
- Students must submit at least two letters of recommendation from teachers who can attest to the student's academic performance and level of maturity needed to be successful in the program. The student must also submit a brief statement explaining their educational and career goals
- 3. <u>Sophomore year:</u> *Provisionally Admitted* to AA program during sophomore year, with teacher recommendations and GPA of 3.2
- 4. <u>Junior Year:</u> Student must be admitted to Thomas University. (Complete application process, submit SAT scores)
- 5. Must have an SAT score of 1000 or an ACT score of 21; earned GPA of 3.2.
- 6. The program will be limited to no more than 15 students per academic year. Each cohort must have a minimum of 8 students. Students must maintain a 3.0 to remain in program.
- Students will move through the course progression as a cohort which will begin the fall of the student's sophomore year (see page 2 & 3 for progression). Students should apply for admission to the program the spring of their freshman year at the Academy.
- All courses must be approved by the high school guidance counselor and the TU advisor.
- Some courses for the associate's degree may be taken through Accel program, funded by the HOPE scholarship and available to high school juniors and seniors. Courses which qualify under Accel are those which meet the core graduation requirements for college preparatory students as defined by the Georgia Student Finance Commission (www.gsfc.org), including English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science and Foreign Language.

Other required courses will be offered at the Accel tuition rate.
