

## SCHOLARS ACADEMY ACADEMIC / BEHAVIOR CONTRACT 2014 - 2015

## As parents and students in the Thomasville City Schools Scholars Academy, we agree to the following Academic / Behavior Contract:

## **Expectations of Scholars:**

## Academic Rigor:

- Scholars Academy supports rigorous academic work and standards.
- A scholar is a learned person who does not merely study for a test but strives for mastery of knowledge.
- We have a goal of continually increasing the numbers of designated AP Scholars. For the 2013-2014 school year our school had a total of 53 designated: including 26 AP Scholar, 14 AP Scholar with Honors, 12 AP Scholar with Distinction, and 1 AP National Scholar.

## **Academic Honesty:**

- Scholars Academy stresses academic honesty and will uphold high standards in this area.
- Students are expected to produce creative and original work. Adhering to citation guidelines is necessary to avoid plagiarism, stealing another person's ideas.
- Teachers, students, and parents agree to report known infractions for which the staff of Scholars Academy will take proper action.

#### Behavior:

- All students are expected to abide by the rules and regulations already set down in the handbooks for MacIntyre Park Middle School and Thomasville High School.
- The most frequent issues involve attendance, dress code, and cell phone violations; these offenses directly impact instructional time.
- Because addressing each issue involves more than just the student in violation of the rules, parents need to be supportive of policies set forth for the benefit of every student.

## Consequences of Violations:

#### **Academic Probation:**

- A student will be placed on academic probation (and will remain on probation) if the student's semester average is below an 80.
- If the student achieves an average of 80 or above the following term, the student will be removed from probation.
- If required average is not met, the student will be referred to the Academic Review Committee which will determine whether or not to dismiss the student from Scholars Academy.

#### Academic Dismissal:

- Any final, failing grade at the end of the year will result in dismissal from Scholars Academy.
- Continued occurrences of academic dishonesty will result in dismissal from Scholars Academy.
- The Academic Committee votes for dismissal, due to failure of correcting academic probation.

#### **Behavioral Detention:**

- First, the teacher will verbally address the minor misbehavior with the student.
- Second, the teacher will notify the parent of the continuing minor offense.
- Third, the teacher will assign detention for continuing the minor infraction.

#### **Behavioral Referral:**

- If the student continues to display the same minor offense, the teacher will send a referral to administration.
- If the misbehavior is a major offense, the teacher will send a referral to administration.

## In-School Suspension (ISS):

- Administration assigns the length of time served in ISS as outlined in the handbooks of MacIntrye Park and Thomasville High.
- Although students are physically removed from the regular school setting during ISS, the ISS program allows students to make up missed work.
- Students who have been assigned ISS will not be allowed, during the period of suspension, to participate in any extra-curricular activities or to attend any school sponsored events.
- Middle school students will serve In-School Suspension at MacIntyre Park Middle School.
- High school students will serve In-School Suspension at Thomasville High School.

#### Out of School Suspension (OSS):

- Administration assigns the length of time served in OSS as outlined in the handbooks of MacIntrye Park and Thomasville High.
- Students who have been suspended from school will not be allowed to participate in any extra-curricular
  activities, attend any school-sponsored events, or be on any Thomasville City Schools property during the
  period of suspension.

## Behavioral Dismissal/Expulsion:

- Three referrals to the administrative office in any year will result in the student's appearance before the Scholars Academy's Discipline Committee.
- Determinations from the committee will result in the formation of an individual student behavior contract or dismissal from Scholars Academy.
- Parents and students may appeal dismissal.
