# LUNCH DELIVERY SAFETY POLICY

Securing our campus during 5th period when a few vehicles deliver lunch while over 300 students are passing through the same driveway has continually been an issue. The staff is posted on duty in the back circle to remind students to use the crosswalks. The staff is also watching for any abnormal activity.

Looking for other options, some students have ventured into places where they are not allowed and are not approved as supervised areas during the lunch period in order to meet parents to pick up lunches. Lt. Hampton of the Thomasville City Police Department has observed these challenges.

If you desire to bring a lunch to a student at the Scholars Academy, please use the following guidelines.

- 1. Parents should bring the lunch and meet the student in the foyer at the front office when the lunch period begins.
- 2. The front office staff should not be expected to call the student out of class.
- 3. Students should not wait for long periods in the foyer for delivery of a meal; delivery should be complete at the beginning of the lunch period. Be aware of the exact time of your student's lunch period.
- 4. The meals provided in the cafeteria are free for all students, so no student will be without a meal unless he/she chooses not to eat.
