Wilton High School is a public high school located in eastern Iowa 30 miles from Iowa City and 30 miles from the Quad Cities just south of Interstate 80 in Muscatine County. The City of Wilton has a population of approximately 3000 with a small industry and agricultural economic base. Higher education opportunities within commuting distance include the University of Iowa in Iowa City, St. Ambrose University, Western Illinois University, Palmer College of Chiropractic, Augustana College, Kaplan College, and Scott Community College in the Quad Cities, Muscatine Community College in Muscatine, Mount Mercy College, Coe College, and Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids, and Cornell College in Mount Vernon.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must earn 26 units of credit including successful completion of the following required credits:

Classes meet for 85 minute blocks on alternating days, except Physical Education, which meets every fourth day for 85 minutes. All courses count 0.5 units per semester except for Physical Education, which is 0.125 units per semester.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT AND COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES

Wilton High School offers AP English Literature & Composition, AP Calculus AB, and AP Biology II. Juniors and seniors may enroll in college classes through the Iowa Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Act and receive dual credit for these courses. In addition, contracted courses are available for dual college and high school credit, such as the Industrial Technology Academy, Chef's Apprenticeship Program, Statistics, Psychology, Sociology, and Macroeconomics. In 2009-

2010 sixty Wilton students enrolled in 136 college courses and earned 401 semester hours of college credit through these dual enrollment options.
