Program Policies:

Our program policies and procedures are to ensure a safe, supervised environment that allows youth to grow and develop.

- Parent pick-up: parents are asked to pick up their child Mondays-Wednesdays at 5:45 P.M. and on Fridays at 12:00 P.M. Only those names on the child's enrollment form are allowed to pick up the child.
- Walk-Home: Children will be allowed to walk-home **only** if a Signed Permission to Walk Home Form is on file.
- Attendance: youth attend a minimum of ten (10) days per month.
- Each day youth have 45-60 min. of homework time, where they will receive the help and tutoring they need to succeed. However, it is not guaranteed that the student will finish his/her homework every day. Students that work diligently on their homework but do not finish will not be withheld from enrichment activities.
- Bobcats Beyond the Bell Club is an opportunity and a privilege, and therefore it is expected that students respect the staff and their peers and obey the program's expectations. We follow the PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports) framework
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- Parents and families are expected to participate in afterschool activities and classes when offered.
