## Basic PBIS Ideas:

- Behaviors are learned, and therefore must be taught. The classroom is where the majority of instruction must occur. Most discipline situations will be handled in the classroom. Like any new concept, behavioral lessons must be taught and reviewed consistently throughout the year.
- Our children that attend all day are between the ages of 5 and 8. It is the job of the teacher to instruct our children in a positive, encouraging way so that we can instill a love of learning about ALL subjects, including social behavior. Behavior lessons should address a variety of learning styles and student backgrounds.
- Building-wide incentives work in the classroom when all staff members use them consistently. For example, students and their families notice when there are significant differences between teachers in the way they distribute panther paws.
- Educating students is a job we all share. Students need regular reminders that it is not just their teacher they must listen to and show respectful behavior toward.
- Modeling behaviors and providing visual reminders of tasks and expectations are beneficial and necessary.
