From the Superintendent's Desk

1:1 Computing at BGHS—Transforming Teaching and Learning

This week on Thursday there will be a meeting for parents of 2013-2014 BGHS students to discuss the possibility of each BGHS student being provided an iPad for use in the school setting. I know that may raise many questions—which is why we are having a parent meeting this Thursday to talk about this exciting possibility.

I want to focus on the educational reasons why we have been working toward this for the past few years. Research shows (http://www.projectred.org/) that schools in which students have access to a computing device perform at higher levels, have fewer disciplinary actions, have fewer students dropping out, and have higher graduation rates than schools without a computing device for each student. This increase in student achievement and engagement is crucial as we continue to forge ahead at BGHS.

PTSC began years ago working on the infrastructure of the district to prepare for an environment at BGHS where every student would have an electronic device. For the past couple of years, the online instruction day has provided teachers with an opportunity to create a digital learning environment that explores teaching and learning in non-traditional formats. This year, PTSC wrote and just received a grant through the eLearning department at the Indiana Department of Education to provide teachers with further professional development in the creation of digital content for students. All of these events help us to move toward a more learner-centric environment in which teachers are better able to focus on the needs of individual students and students are better able to take control of their own learning.

Is the iPad the answer to everything we need to do to move BGHS forward educationally? Absolutely not! It is another tool in the hands of our talented teachers and students to help us achieve our goal of reaching every student, every day, moving them toward reaching their full potential. We will still use materials we already own to help us accomplish this goal. It will be a transition to move toward digital curriculum and digital content creation by students. As we look at how to prepare students for a future we ourselves cannot envision (see October 8th newsletter), it is imperative that we are working to provide them with the technological tools they will need to be successful beyond our walls. This is an exciting future, an exciting possibility, and a place where I know I'd want to go to school. Join us Thursday night to learn even more (and the specifics) about this possibility.
