JOBDESCRIPTION: (Synopsis, full position description upon request)

Provide one-on-one instructional assistance with a special needs student from the Olathe School District. (May eventually work with several students)

- Facilitates communication between the target student and his/her peers and teachers.
- Facilitates highly academic information that is out of the target student's language range.
- Provides a prompt, a verbal model, and direct student to verbally imitate target phrase.
- Directs the student's attention to attend to target/task.
- Provides Cultural Mediation.
- Encourages and supports the student to communicate with her/his peers and instructors independently.
- Provides spoken English support/opportunities.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Ability to communicate effectively in sign language and English with student, staff, parents. Ability to work cooperatively. Ability to correctly operate school machines, tools, and equipment. High School diploma or GED. AA or higher degree or training working with students preferred. Fluent in American Sign Language and English. ASL and English assessments will be given at the time of interview.
