



FAMILY ASL IMMERSION CAMP CHILD CARE SUPERVISOR

Receives oral, written and signed instruction related to Family ASL Immersion Camp to support families in learning ASL supervising child care for children ages 0-5. The ASL Camp Child care Supervisor will be responsible for scheduling volunteers to care and plan activities during the camp, gather and organize materials and snacks for the activities, and communicating regularly with the ASL Camp coordinator prior to and throughout the events.

Supervision is related to classroom organization, set up and volunteers. Provides language models and directs participants to learn the vocabulary or phrases. Directs the student's attention to specific places in the room. Recruitment of volunteers must be completed by May 1, 2018.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High School graduate or GED, Fluency in manual communication; ability to understand and use English and ASL in appropriate modes; ability to listen and be empathetic to participants; ability to be a positive role model.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Upon offer of employment, a background check will be conducted via the KS Bureau of Investigation, Backgrounds Plus, Kansas Department of Children and Family Services, Work Reference and Kansas Offender Register. A Tuberculosis test & Health Certificate must be passed upon offer of employment (cost borne by employee).
