



FAMILY ASL IMMERSION CAMP DEAF MENTOR

Receives oral, written and signed instruction related to Family ASL Immersion Camp to support families in learning ASL. Supervision is related to classroom organization or material by instructor. Instruction is specific to the Deaf Mentor Curriculum in a scope and sequence manner. Provides language models and directs participants to use the vocabulary or phrases being taught. Support the participants acquisition of ASL. Holds discussions in both ASL and English. Directs the student's attention to specific places in the room or toward the discussion. Has high expectations for participants to reach a beginner conversational level in ASL.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High School graduate or GED, Fluency in manual communication; ability to understand and use English and ASL in appropriate modes; ability to listen and be empathetic to participants; ability to be a positive role model.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Upon offer of employment, a background check will be conducted via the KS Bureau of Investigation, Backgrounds Plus, Kansas Department of Children and Family Services, Work Reference and Kansas Offender Register. A Tuberculosis test & Health Certificate must be passed upon offer of employment (cost borne by employee).
