Thank you for your interest in volunteering at the Kansas School for the Deaf. The information below lists the different volunteer opportunities and the requirements and application process for each.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR VOLUNTEERING AT KSD

- Volunteer on a regular basis
- Volunteer for events, as needed
- Volunteer as a large group for a community service project
- Volunteer in order to fulfill high school graduation requirement

VOLUNTEERING ON A REGULAR BASIS

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must:

- be eighteen (18) years of age or older
- demonstrate conversational skill level in American Sign Language
- pass a background check
- be able to wait up to 2 months to start volunteering

HOW DO I APPLY?

Fill out a volunteer application which can be found at this link ______. After completing the application, send it to Lori Colwell via email to lcolwell@kssdb.org or mail to her at KSD.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SUBMIT MY APPLICATION?

Your application will be reviewed and if there is a need that fits your availability and interest, Lori will contact you to arrange a time to meet to:

- verify your ASL skills
- give you background check paperwork to fill out and sign
- get a copy of your Driver's License and Social Security card.

Upon passing the background check, you will go through a volunteer orientation and meet the staff person you will be assisting before you begin to volunteer.



VOLUNTEERING FOR EVENTS (ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS):

Send an email to Lori Colwell at lcolwell@kssdb.org and include the following information:

- name
- age (must be at least 16 years of age)
- area of interest such as athletics, public events, camps etc.

As needs arise, Lori will send you an email to inquire about your availability.

VOLUNTEERING IN ORDER TO FULFILL HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant must:

- be over the age of 16
- demonstrate conversational skill level in American Sign Language
- verify that the hours needed are to fulfill graduation requirements
- submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher
- have parent approval

Fill out the volunteer application which can be found at this link ______. After completing the application, send it to Lori Colwell via email to lcolwell@kssdb.org or mail to her at KSD.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SUBMIT MY APPLICATION?

Your application will be reviewed and if there is a need that fits your availability and interest, you will be asked to submit verification of the need for volunteer hours to fulfill your graduation requirements. You will then meet with Lori to:

- verify your ASL skills
- turn in your letter of recommendation
- go through a volunteer orientation with a parent
- meet the staff person you will be assisting
