



# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: 2015

The 2015 admission requirements are listed here and at [admissions.ku.edu/2015req](http://admissions.ku.edu/2015req).

## KANSANS

Complete the Kansas Qualified Admissions curriculum (see below) with a 2.0+ GPA on a 4.0 scale

### AND

21+ACT/980+ SAT (math and critical reading only)

### OR

rank in the top one-third of your high school class

Student must also achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school.

## NONRESIDENTS

Complete the Kansas Qualified Admissions curriculum (see below) with a 2.5+ GPA on a 4.0 scale

### AND

24+ACT/1090+ SAT (math and critical reading only)

### OR

rank in the top one-third of your high school class

Student must also achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school.

*All students are encouraged to apply. A student who does not meet these standards will be considered for admission through the Board of Regents' exceptions window and may be admitted as a conditional admit after a review of their application. If a student is admitted as a conditional admit, information will be provided in their admit letter. For most conditional admit students, they must complete 24 credit hours with a 2.0 GPA in their first year at KU.*

## KANSAS BOARD OF REGENTS QUALIFIED ADMISSIONS PRE-COLLEGE CURRICULUM

For 2015 high school graduates

**English: 4 units required**

**Natural Science: 3 units required**

One year must be chemistry or physics.

**Mathematics: 3 units and ACT/SAT college readiness math benchmark (22 math ACT/540 math SAT) OR 4 units required with one being in the senior year**

**Social Science: 3 units required**

Must include instruction in U.S. history, U.S. government, and geography

**Electives: 3 units required**

Units must be from the following areas:

- Career and technical education
- Computer/information systems
- English
- Fine arts
- Foreign languages
- Journalism
- Mathematics
- Natural science
- Personal finance
- Social science
- Speech, debate, forensics

One unit represents one year or two semesters.

# UNIVERSITY OF KANSAS 2015 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## Freshman Applicants

### Kansas and Out-of-state Residents:

The following grid shows several student academic scenarios for Spring, Summer and Fall 2015 admission decisions. Please refer to this chart as a guideline when advising students on their potential for admission to KU. SAT references are math and critical reading only.

Scenario	ACT or SAT	Is the Board of Regents curriculum complete with a 2.0 or higher (KS) or 2.5 or higher (out-of-state)?	This is how the student will be admitted or reviewed for a decision by KU
1	21 ACT (980 SAT) or higher	Yes	Full admit
2	Top-third of class (regardless of ACT or SAT)	Yes	Full admit
3	17-20 ACT (820-970 SAT) AND 3.01 cumulative GPA or higher	Yes	Conditional admit
4	17-20 ACT (820-970 SAT) AND 3.0 cumulative GPA or lower	Yes	Review for decision
5	16 ACT (810 SAT) or lower	Yes	Review for decision
6	21 ACT (980 SAT) or higher	No	Conditional admit if missing one course. If missing more than one course, review for decision.
7	Top-third of class with 17-20 ACT (820-970 SAT)	No	Review for decision
8	17-20 ACT (820-970 SAT)	No	Review for decision
9	16 ACT (810 SAT) or lower	No	Review for decision

*\*Review for decision means additional review is taking place by the Office of Admissions. There are too many combinations of scenarios to cover all situations. The review looks at **all** of the student's academic criteria to make a decision.*
