BJES Kindergarten Registration Friday, March 15th

A kindergarten child who will be 6 yrs. old by August 1, 2019 must enroll in kindergarten. The child may enroll if he/she will be 5 yrs. old by August 1, 2019. Kindergarten attendance is mandatory in Kentucky. Please bring the following information: child's birth certificate (official certified copy signed by the registrar of the child's state of birth), and the child's immunization records.

BJES Head Start & Pre-School Registration Friday, March 15th

Any child who is 3 or 4 yrs. old by August 1, 2019 is eligible to register for HS. Any child who will be 4 yrs. by August 1, 2019 is eligible to register for the Pre-K program. Acceptance is based upon Federal income guidelines. Before an application can be considered, the following information must be provided: family income verification and birth verification (official certified copy of signed by the registrar of the child's state of birth, hospital birth certificate, and immunization records).

Transportation will be Provided for 2019-2020!
