Parents,

Each day our busses travel approximately 4900 miles transporting students to and from school. As you are well aware, sometimes in inclement weather we cannot travel all roads safely. As an alternative to missing extended periods of school we have prepared a “State Highway Plan” for each bus route. We will not use this option unless we have missed school at least one day prior or we experience inclement weather over the weekend and must make a decision on Sunday as to whether or not we will attend school on Monday. In either instance, notification of the “State Highway Plan” will be made the day before we use it. We will continue to operate as we have done for several years and will try to run as many roads as possible. However, in the event we can travel State Highways safely and cannot travel the majority of the County Roads, we may use this as an alternative to missing school.

Notification of school closings and delays will be made on several TV and radio stations. Our first priority will be WXBC 104.3, Weather Hotline (756-3125) and Notify Me Text Alerts.

- **In an effort to eliminate confusion, we will only travel roads in the afternoon that we travel in the morning.**

- **State Highways are roads that are numbered. (Hwy. 259, Hwy. 60, Hwy. 992, etc.)**
- **County Roads are named roads. (Willie Simmons Rd., Kirk Axtel Rd., Bewleyville-Rosetta Rd., etc.)**
