DISCIPLINE DATA UPDATE

Discipline Referrals in **August 2016** = 148 Discipline Referrals in **August 2017** = 99

177 Minors vs. 104 Colonel Cash

28% of discipline referrals are assigned on Thursdays!

 9^{th} grade = 38% discipline referrals

10th grade = 32% discipline referrals

11th grade = **20**% discipline referrals

12th grade = 9% discipline referrals

Aside from classroom referrals, the CAFETERIA is the area in which the highest number of referrals are assigned.


