Discipline Referrals in **August 2016** = 148

Discipline Referrals in **August 2017** = 99

177 Minors vs. 104 Colonel Cash

28% of discipline referrals are assigned on **Thursdays!**

9th grade = **38%** discipline referrals

10th grade = **32%** discipline referrals

11th grade = **20%** discipline referrals

12th grade = **9%** discipline referrals
