

Drawing Task

- 1.** Pick an object in your house. You will do an observational drawing. While looking **only at the object**, put your pencil to paper and draw it without picking up your pencil. Don't cheat!!! Now add some color to your crazy drawing.
 - 2.** Find a beautiful picture in a magazine or print one off the internet, cut it out, and make that the center of your drawing.
 - 3.** Pick a quote and illustrate it. (Yes you may Zentangle)
 - 4.** What's your favorite fairy tale? Draw or paint your favorite scene. You may add color! You may use any media (pencil, pen, markers, or paint) to complete this assignment.
 - 5.** Pick a lyric from one of your favorite songs and illustrate it. Beneath the sketch list the song title and artist.
 - 6.** Think about something in your everyday life that you take for granted, and devote your sketch to it. Beneath it, describe what it is.
 - 7.** Pick three colors. Draw an animal or insect using a pen, and then use only those three colors to fill it in.
 - 8.** Draw three things you can't go without (with shading please). Suggested material: pencil or pen. Beneath it, briefly describe what they are and why you need each item.
 - 9.** Create a comic strip. Focus on lines only – no shading! Add color - think Pop Art. Suggested material: pencil, pen, or marker.
 - 10.** Block print your name or initials in the middle of the page. Fill all the negative space with doodles (Zentangle) Suggested material: pen. You may add color
