PAYMENTS - MONEY ORDERS ONLY

Senior Budget (A – budget only) must be paid in **two payments** of **\$225.00** on **August 26, 2011 and September 23, 2011**. **Deadline: Oct. 28, 2011**

Senior Paraphernalia is due by **September 1, 2011**. Please submit size for T-shirt and sweatshirt. This is optional therefore **ONLY** pre-paid items will be ordered.

Senior budget (B – includes budget and trip) must be paid in **FOUR(4) payments**: **TWO** payments of **\$225.00** each on **August 26, 2011, September 23, 2011, and TWO** payments of **\$375.00** each on **October 28, 2011, and November 18, 2011 (MONEY ORDERS ONLY)**.

***ACCORDING TO ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS SENIORS MUST COMPLETE A TERM PAPER TO GRADUATE. IF THE TERM PAPER IS NOT COMPLETE, THE STUDENT MAY NOT ATTEND THE SENIOR TRIP.**

Deadline: December 15, 2011 (reservations must be made at this time.) Payments should be given to Mrs. Garibaldi in the main office, in the morning before school, at lunch, or afterschool (MONEY ORDERS ONLY). Please make money orders payable to McDonogh 35 and place students name in the memo section. Students will not be allowed to make payments during instructional time. Parents who wish to make payments will be allowed to do so at anytime during school hours.

SPECIAL NOTE: All senior events are pre-paid contractual events; therefore your child will be assessed a late fee of \$50 on accounts in past due status because of vendor accommodations. If your child is suspended or does not attend an event, money **WILL NOT** be refunded for prepaid events. In the event your child does not graduate due to academic or behavioral probation, please adhere to the refund schedule listed below:

1. After five weeks from the beginning of the fall semester, a refund of 50 percent of senior budget will be refunded.
2. NO REFUNDS ARE ALLOWED AFTER THE NINTH WEEK OF CLASSES.

ATTIRE FOR ALL SENIOR EVENTS

Students **MUST** adhere to the appropriate attire for all Senior events as outlined below:

Senior Chapel Attire

Ladies: White dress, suit, or skirt and blouse - **NO PANTS!!!!**

Skirt dress length: no more than three inches above the knee

Shoes (2 - 3 inches only): Gold, Silver, Neutral/Nude or White heels (**NO FLATS, CASUAL SANDALS, BOOTS, OR FLIP FLOPS – SEE EXAMPLE ATTACHMENT**)

Gentlemen: Black Pants, long sleeved white shirt, black socks, black dress shoes and black or combination black and white tie. **MUST WEAR TIE - NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**

PROM

Ladies: LONG FORMAL GOWNS (NO Short or T-Length Formal Gowns or Dresses,)

Gowns should NOT: expose navel or abdominal region, **not** pass mid section of back (lower part of scapula), splits should **NOT** pass mid thigh, should **NOT** be short in the front and have a long train in the back. **NO EXCEPTIONS! (SEE EXAMPLE ATTACHMENT)**

Gentlemen: Tuxedo and tuxedo or dress shoes. (No casual shoes such as Prada, Gucci, Cole Haan, or Tennis shoes) **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!**

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN!!! ALL ATTENDEES MUST BE DRESSED APPROPRIATELY!!! PLEASE INFORM YOUR DATES OF THE DRESS CODE, BECAUSE THEY WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPER ATTIRE ALSO.

SENIOR PICNIC

Class shirts are optional. **NO see through or revealing clothes. No shorts pass mid thigh (NO DAISY DUKE SHORTS)**

AWARDS NIGHT -

The Dress Code is the same as Senior Chapel. (Please see above)





SENIOR PRIDE DAY

Theme: Professional Business Day

The purpose of Senior Pride Day is to give seniors an opportunity to dress as expected in a professional setting. Therefore, we trust that seniors will exercise good judgment in the selection of their attire for Senior Pride Day. It is expected that all seniors who participate will comply with the guidelines set forth by McDonogh 35 and the Orleans Parish School Board Student Dress Code.

- 1. Students may not wear suggestive or revealing attire, e.g. no plunging necklines, bare midriffs, skin tight clothing, tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, cold-shoulder attire or strapless attire.**
- 2. No shorts, including Capri length and gym shorts.**
- 3. No caps, hats, or head scarves.**
- 4. No shoes without backs. This includes slippers, shower thongs, etc.**
- 5. Lady Roneagles: no mini-skirts or mini-dresses.**
- 6. No pants worn below the waist revealing undergarments.**
- 7. No jeans, no tennis shoes.**
- 8. Students must wear their school ID.**
- 9. Students who violate this dress code will be subject to disciplinary action.**

GRADUATION

Ladies: All white dress, suit, or skirt and blouse. Shoes: Neutral/Nude Color heels (2 – 3 inches)

ONLY.

Gentlemen: Black pants, white shirt, tie, dress socks and black dress shoes.

(NO SUNSHADES NOR EARRINGS ALLOWED)

Gentlemen: Tuxedo and tuxedo or dress shoes. (**No casual shoes such as soft sole Prada, Gucci, Cole Haan, or Tennis shoes**) **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
