## **Online Summer School Credit Recovery**

Hello Parents and Guardians:

This year, Calhoun is offering an online credit recovery program for middle and high school students through the Grandview R2 school district. Grandview's online summer school program is accredited by DESE and provides our students with opportunities to recover missing credits during the summer months.

To enroll students, please complete the following paperwork, as well as enroll them online with the following steps:

- 1) Go to : <http://www.grandviewr2.com/virtual-summer-school-2086ff82>
- 2) Click on your students' school group (High school OR Middle school)
- 3) Complete the online form

Please note that in order for students to receive credit, they are NOT allowed to enroll in any other summer programs, and must complete all necessary work and pass with at least a 60%.

Furthermore, Ms. Russell will be hosting times for students to come in to complete the online work after the end of the school year from May 18<sup>th</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup>. Students are allowed to attend from 8am to 11am or from 12pm to 3pm. Breakfast/Lunch WILL NOT be provided. **If a student does not complete their course work by June 1<sup>st</sup>, they can complete it online at home or any area with Wifi. It is the student's responsibility to complete all work.**

MOSI is a free virtual summer school program offering more than 90 courses for original credit or credit recovery. Courses are either one semester (0.5 credits) or two semesters (1.0 credit) in length as indicated in the course list (■ or ■■). Students may not be enrolled in more than two semester courses at any one time (up to a total of 1.0 credit). In no event may students take more than four courses or a maximum of 2.0 credits during the summer. Students are responsible for providing their own computer and internet access. MOSI is open to all Missouri students in grades 7-12.

**IMPORTANT:** According to Section 167.227 RSMO, "No pupil shall attend summer school courses in more than one district during any one summer." Students enrolling in MOSI may not enroll in and attend summer school courses at another district, and students who enroll in another summer school program are ineligible to enroll in MOSI.

Every Missouri high school student is required to earn 24 units of credit in order to graduate. This includes earning a certain number of credits in the following subject areas:

Physical Education (PE) 1 credit    Personal Finance (PF) ½ credit  
 Fine Art (FA) 1 credit    Health (H) ½ credit  
 Practical Art (PA) 1 credit

Some schools may only allow 0.5 transfer credits for PE

CTE courses are a great elective choice to learn about various career options. We offer courses in four career clusters.

*Agriculture, Health Science, Hospitality & Tourism, and STEM*

We are also offering a "Business and IT Boot Camp" this summer. Each course is 3 weeks long and will follow a specific schedule of instruction. Students may enroll in only one Boot Camp course during each session. Computer Literacy is a prerequisite course.
