Score Point 2

Problem: The baboons keep eating the crops.

Solution: Don't plant crops no more.

Score Point 1

The response includes **ONLY** the farmers' main problem with the maize crop.

Problem: "The baboons keep eating the crops."
< "Don't plant crops no more." is **NOT** an appropriate text-based solution.

Problem: It is always is dry.

Solution: It needs to rain more there.

Score Point 0

The response does NOT indicate the farmers' main problem with the maize crop OR an appropriate text-based solution.

< "It is always is dry." and "It needs to rain more there." are NOT appropriate text-based problems or solutions.

Score Point 2

The response includes TWO text-based ways the tyava, or boom-stick, is a good tool for the boys to use.

< "Because of the baboons" is too vague to receive credit.

1. The schools hold two sessions each day because of the weather.
2. The schools also wanted rain so they could have better crops.

Score Point 0

The response does NOT include an appropriate text-based reason schools in the villages of the Zimbabwe countryside hold two sessions each day .

< "The schools hold two sessions each day because of the weather."

< "The schools also wanted rain so they could have better crops." are NOT appropriate text-based reasons.

Part A- Score Point 1

The response includes ONE appropriate text-based description of how the boys are either brave OR responsible.

> Responsible: "Guarding the cornfields is one of the boys responsibilities."

< Brave: "have to show courage to guard the cornfields." is NOT an acceptable response.

Part B- Score Point 0

The chart is NOT appropriately labeled.

< "Example" is an acceptable label; however, "Duties" is NOT acceptable.
