Lost & Found...

With the cold weather upon us that means kids will be bringing more items to school to stay warm... which in turn means more items to keep track of! Teachers do their best to help kids make sure they have everything, but with 600+ students in the elementary school that is a lot of gloves, hats and coats. Now would be a good time to give your child extra reminders to be responsible for their own items and please mark their names in their coats and hats especially. We have been diligent about frequently going through and returning any items that are labeled with a child's name. This really is the best way to help get lost or forgotten items returned... label EVERYTHING with your child's name!

Parking lot reminders...

As everyone has become more settled into their morning routines, please remember to follow the guidelines and procedures of the parking lot and street drop off and pick up. Please refrain from dropping off your child around the curve and in the left hand lane unless you are pulled up closer to the middle crosswalk. No student for any reason should cross traffic in the middle of the parking lot and must cross at the crosswalks where a member of our team is making sure all is safe to cross. We have many adults out in the morning to open doors. However, do not feel that your students have to wait for someone to open the door for them. If you are stopped past the lower crosswalk and in the right lane, students can then open the door and head into the building. This helps to keep the flow of traffic moving and makes drop off more efficient. Double parking is not allowed and dropping or picking up in the bike lane is considered double parking. Finally, please refrain from being on your phone in order to keep attention on the many cars and kids!
