GOOGLE APPLICATIONS (CEU)

This course will train students in the basic functions of Google Applications such as word processing, spreadsheets, slides, forms, and classroom. Students will learn applications on their smartphone, tablet, or PC. Instructor– Skylar Mincey, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

INTRODUCTION TO SEWING

Instruction in basic sewing and craft construction. Students must provide own sewing machine. Instructor- Cindy Nowell, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

BASIC WELDING

This course is designed to give students instruction in MIG welding, stick welding, and practice running flat, vertical up, and fillet welding, as well as plasma cutting. Instructor- Randy Kirk, Fee \$100.00 (12 weeks)

COMBINATION WELDING

The objective of this course is to teach safety, metal technology, methods of welding, shield gases, and arc welding (include stick, MIG, TIG, processes), Oxyacetylene cutting, welding, brazing, soldering, and maintenance/care of welding equipment. Instructor-Wille Jarnigian, Fee \$200/2 nights/wk (12 weeks)

AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR

Basic maintenance and trouble shooting of engines. Instructor will cover basic tune up and how to trouble shoot common engine problems. Instructor Lee Busby, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

BASIC PHOTOGRAPHY/ PHOTOSHOP

Students will learn the basic function of camera operation, lenses and their uses, as well as practical methods of photo editing through classroom and hands on training. Instructor– Steve Shaw, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

SMALL ENGINE REPAIR

This course is designed to teach the operation, maintenance, and repair of lawn and garden equipment such as lawnmowers, power saws, motorcycles, outboards, power conveyors, etc. Instructor– Kevin Barnes, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

INTRODUCTION TO CULINARY

This course will introduce students to basic culinary skills, ranging from traditional southern cooking to international cuisine. Plating techniques and food sampling will follow instruction. Instructor– Tara Lauderdale, Fee \$50.00 (6 weeks)

INTRO TO SPANISH(CEU)

The student will practice common nouns and phrases in the Spanish language. Instructor- Sara Rodriguez, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

INTRO TO COMPUTERS (CEU)

This class is designed as an introductory course in computer application software. It provides an introduction to computer concepts and the use of Microsoft Office for Windows (word processing, spreadsheet, and database operations). Instructor- Nan Nethery. Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

INTRODUCTION TO BEEKEEPING

Students will be given beginning instruction on hive establishment and management. Instructor- Lynn Wood, Fee \$35.00 (6 weeks)

BASIC CARPENTRY AND WOODWORKING

This course will introduce the students to basic wood working and carpentry. Instructor– Tim Bradley, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

INTRODUCTION TO INDUSTRIAL MAINTENANCE

This course is designed to introduce students to the field of industrial maintenance. Students will receive an introduction to machine shop practices ,and other industrial maintenance practices. Instructor-Clint Turner, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks)

IINTRO TO DRONES

This course will introduce the student to drone basic knowledge along with regulations and basic flight instruction. Instructor-J. Buie, Fee \$70.00 (12 weeks) Classes will not meet on the following dates, due to school holidays: February 19th, March 12th thru March 16th

CAREER & TECHNOLOGY CENTER

Through the cooperation of the Career and Technical Education Department, the Alcorn Career & Technology Center is organizing adult evening classes. These classes are being conducted to provide training for persons so they may become gainfully employed and to retrain and upgrade those already employed. Provided sufficient interest is shown, the following non-credit courses will be offered.

ADMISSIONS

Any person 16 years of age or older and not enrolled in a high school curriculum is eligible to enroll in adult career education courses.

REGISTRATION

Registration will be held at the Alcorn Career & Technology Center located at 2101 Norman Road, Corinth, MS. A minimum of 12 people will be needed in order for classes to develop.

CREDIT

Adult career courses are non-credit. However, a certificate is issued upon the successful completion of a course. A person missing more than 16% (1 class out of 6) will not be eligible for a certificate.

FEES

Laboratory fees will be charged, but will vary depending on the nature of the course taken. Course fees are listed with every class description. Fees must be paid on the date of registration.

LATE REGISTRATIONS

Late registrations will be accepted through the <u>third regular</u> <u>class meeting</u>; however, classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis.
