SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Eligibility for Scholarship:

1. Any high school student entering college or career school.
2. Proof of graduation or equivalent
3. Student must write an autobiography to include their dreams and goals. The autobiography/essay must include the detail as to how the money will be used and how the applicant will "pay it forward" in their service to others. The autobiography to no less than 50 words and no more than 150 words.
4. The applicant must make an oral presentation to the scholarship committee at the designated time and place. The presentation must be no less than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes.

Selection Process

The scholarship committee members will score each applicant on

1. Timely submission of application.
2. Content, legibility and grammar of written autobiography (may be typed)
3. Delivery of the oral presentation.

The scores will then be tabulated. The two student receiving the highest score will receive the scholarship. If there is a tie, the committee will use a predetermined procedure to break the tie.

Distribution of Scholarship

No funds will be distributed until the student(s) provides

1. Evidence of graduation or equivalent,
2. Copy of College or career school acceptance letter,
3. Copy of class schedule from the school of their choice.

All documents must be from the school or college. The funds will be distributed directly to the student.
