2. In the **Login Section** in the top-right hand corner, type your username and password. Click the **Login** button.

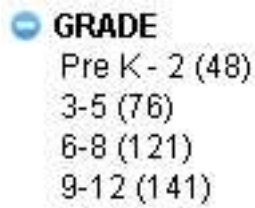
3. The best way to search is by **KEYWORD**.

7. The numbers in the *brackets* represent the LENGTH of the videos. For example, the first video available is titled, “*Martin Luther King, Jr.*” and is five minutes and three seconds long. [05:03]

8. Click on the **BLUE TEXT** to view the video. REMEMBER TO TURN YOUR SOUND UP ON YOUR COMPUTER.
9. To play the video in **FULL SCREEN**, click the *full screen* icon in the bottom right-hand corner of the video.

10. TO EXIT FULL SCREEN, PRESS THE ESCAPE KEY ON YOUR KEYBOARD.

A TECHNICAL NOTE: SOME COMPUTERS WILL PLAY BETTER IN QUICKTIME OR FLASH PLAYER. YOU CAN SWITCH TO QUICKTIME PLAYER OR FLASH PLAYER BY SELECTING THE QUICKTIME BUTTON TO THE RIGHT OF THE VIDEO.



11. To **DOWNLOAD** the movie file to use in your presentation, simply click the **DOWNLOAD** button.



12. To **CITE** your video in your presentation or research, click the **CITATIONS** button. Ask your teacher which format to use.
