### School Orientation for 9th-12th Students

On Wednesday morning, August 8, 9th grade students and their parents will meet in the Activities Building at 8:00 am. This meeting will provide 9th grade parents an opportunity to meet with school counselor and the principal for a brief orientation to help them in planning and preparing for their child's secondary academic career. The 9th grade students will meet their teachers and coaches as they go through a mini-schedule and receive their books and instructions in all classes. 9th grade parents are asked to park in the back parking lot behind the Activities Building.

Homeroom assignments and special instructions will be given at this meeting. All classes will meet briefly, and students will receive their books and assignments from their teachers.
