Buick Achievers Scholarship Program – Seniors planning to enroll in engineering, technology, design or business programs at a four-year university are eligible. See the counselor for additional information. Award amounts range from \$2,000 to \$100,000. Application deadline is **February 27, 2015**. (www.buickachievers.com)

Rowan Scholarship – Applicants must be dependents of a Rowan employee or retiree. An essay describing the applicant's educational and future career goals is required. The \$3,500 annual award may be renewed up to five years. Application deadline is **February 28, 2015**.

Nissan Scholarship – Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and ACT score of 20. FAFSA must be completed. An essay (200 words) is required. Award amounts vary. Deadline is **March 1, 2015**. (www.ihl.state.ms/financialaid/nissan.html)

Justin Pugh Christian Leadership Scholarship – The scholarship is given in memory of Justin Pugh by his family. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and submit a five-paragraph essay about his/her role as a teen Christian leader. Application deadline is **March 6, 2015**.

AABE Scholarship – Minority seniors with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA planning to major in specific areas may apply. Awards range from \$1,000 to \$10,000. Application deadline is **March 6, 2015**. (www.aabe.org)

MORA Scholarship – Seniors must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA and write a short essay on a given topic. Award is \$500. Application deadline is **March 6, 2015**. (www.msora.org)

MCC Literary Review – Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors may enter poems, essays, or short stories. Awards range from \$25 to \$75. Application deadline is **March 6, 2015**.

Murphy-Martin Endowment Scholarship – Applicants must have a relative that is or was a Master Mason in good standing in a Lodge. Award varies. Application deadline is **March 15, 2015**.

Rural Medical Scholars Program – Juniors having a minimum 25 ACT composite score with at least a 24 in Math may apply. Chosen applicants will attend MSU for five weeks during the summer and take two college courses as they learn about a career as a family medicine physician. The program covers tuition, books, and housing. Application deadline is **March 18, 2015**. (www.RMS.msucare.com)

The National WWII Museum Annual Essay Contest – High school students may submit essays of 1,000 words or less on a given subject. Awards range from \$500 to \$1,000. David G. Hall, M.D. Memorial Scholarship - The Mississippi Academy of Family Physicians Foundation Board of Trustees awards scholarships to seniors who have an aptitude in the sciences and an interest in pursuing a career in the field of medicine. Applicants must submit a 500-word essay. Awards range up to \$1000. Application deadline is **March 31, 2015**. (www.msafp.org)

MCC General and President/Dean/Eagle Scholarships – Seniors planning to attend Meridian Community College next Fall should complete these scholarship forms and return them to Mrs. Dedwylder. Award amount varies. Suggested deadline is **April 1, 2015**.

MCC Honors College – Seniors must meet ACT and GPA requirements. Honors students will have opportunities to attend honors classes and special events. Applications should be completed as soon as possible.

The Good South Scholarship – High school seniors and current undergraduate college students may apply for this scholarship. A resume and short essay are required. Award is \$250 to \$500. Application deadline is **April 1, 2015**. (www.thegoodsouth.com/pages/our-cause)

Walmart Dependent Scholarship – Seniors with a minimum 2.0 GPA, a parent employed by Walmart, and proof of financial need may apply. Awards range up to \$13,000. Application deadline is **April 1, 2015**. (<https://walmart.scholarsapply.org/dependent/contact.php>)

Enterprise Small Business Scholarship – The scholarship program recognizes young people with an interest in small business development. Applicants must submit a business plan for a proposed business. Award is \$500. Application deadline is **April 1, 2015**.

L.J. Davis Scholarship – The scholarship is sponsored by the L.J. Davis family in his honor. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and 100 hours of community service. The award is \$500. Application deadline is **April 3, 2015**.

UWA BOSS Scholarship – Applicants must attend UWA and major in biological and environmental science, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and prove financial need. Award ranges up to \$34,000. Application deadline is **April 15, 2015**. (www.uwa.edu/uwaboss/)
