

Logging In

When a district or state registers a school, the school login and password information is sent to the school principal and the process manager via email. The password may also be given out at a training held by the district or state. With this information, the principal or process manager may log in to Indistar® through the state's website, if the state has posted a link there or through the "Indistar Login" <u>http://www.indistar.org/</u>.
