Hello Parents,

We're now running the second half of the race. February 20th, all 11th graders will be taking the ACT. This is a very important test. If a student did not pass his or her state exam, English II, Algebra I, Biology I, or U.S. History, the ACT could help. A score of 17 on the English section of the ACT will suffice for the English II exam; a score of 17 on the math section will suffice for the Algebra I exam; a score of 17 on the Reading section will suffice for U.S. History exam; and a score of 17 on the Science section will suffice for Biology I exam. Additionally, our goal is for every student to score 23 or better on the ACT. This will not only help them with the state exams, but will also help students to get scholarship money for college.

Here are the numbers for our Academic Awards. For the second term, we have 8 Superintendent Scholars, 54 Principal Scholars, and 54 Honor Roll Scholars. Parents here's where we really need your help. We expect to have tripled that number of student for each category. We should have had 350 academic scholars or more. Please encourage our finest to do their very best each and every day.

Parents, thank you for sending your very best to school every day. Our daily attendance has averaged around 90%! Keep up the good work so that we can reach our goal of 95%.
