"From the Principal's Desk"

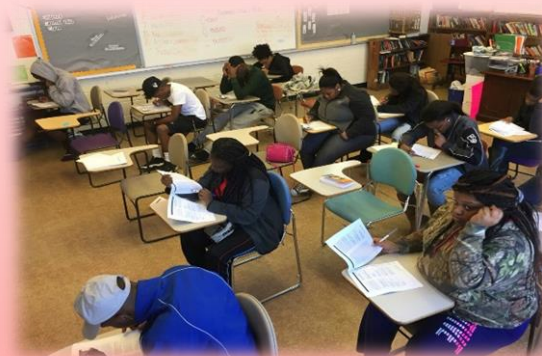
