MS-CPAS2 Around the Corner

As the 3rd Nine weeks comes to an end, the Indianola Career and Technical Center prepares for the much awaited MS-CPAS2. The MS-CPAS2 is a Career and Technical Education (CTE) Assessment used to provide a fair means of establishing accountability for both the secondary and postsecondary CTE programs.

Although the MS-CPAS2 is not a state requirement for high school graduation, it does serve as a tool that measures students' mastery of competencies in the course curricula. In the performance-based assessment, students encounter work-based scenarios similar to challenges they may face in the "real world," providing instructors and outside evaluators a unique opportunity to see how students would perform in their actual fields.

Most importantly, a MS-CPAS2 score of 60 along with a 36 on the ASVAB will satisfy the graduation requirement for specific subject area tests.
