Hands-On Learning Activity



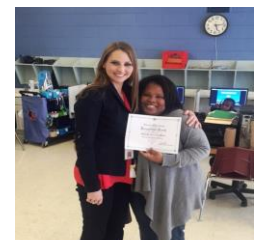
Students in Ms. Teresa Harris's math classes enjoyed learning about measurement. They created silhouettes of each other and measured the silhouettes using various units.

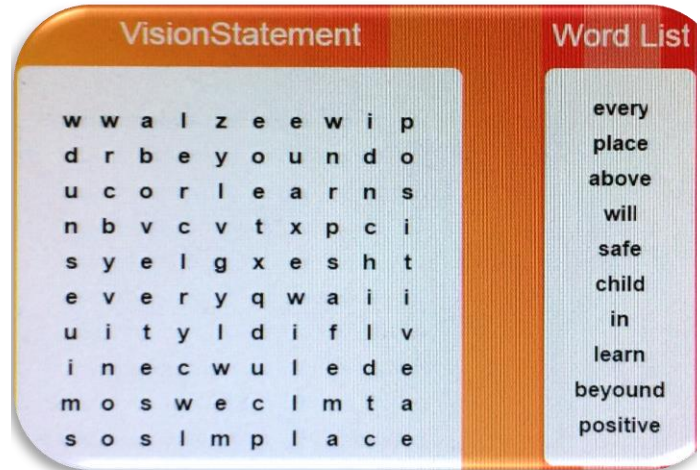
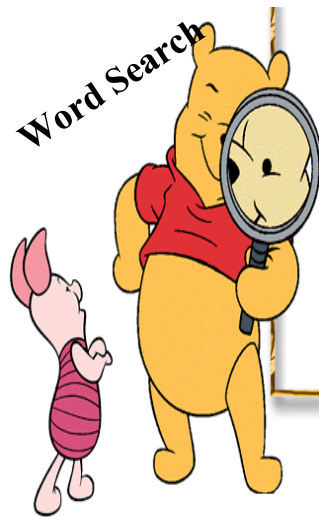
