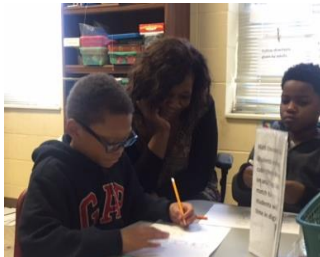
Using the Online Library

Teacher and Student



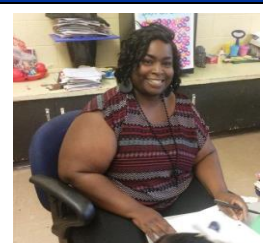

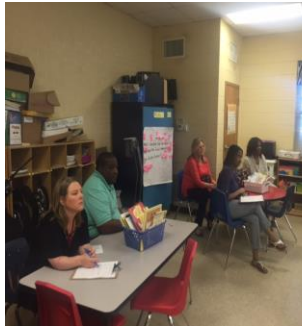
