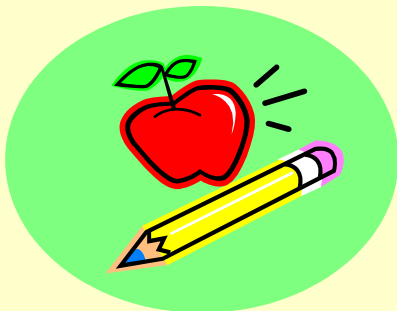

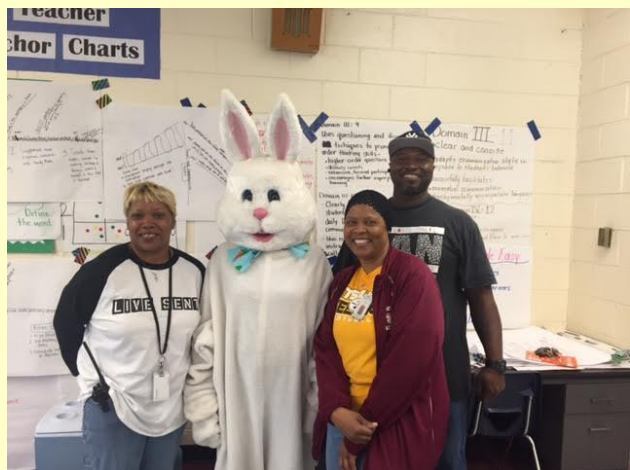

STAR TESTING

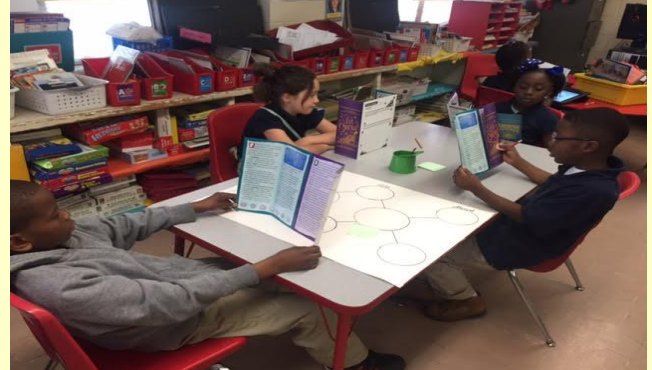
To be promoted:

1st grade students need a score of 675 on the STAR Early Literacy test plus a class average of 70.

2nd grade students need a score of 241 on the STAR Ready test plus a class average of 70.

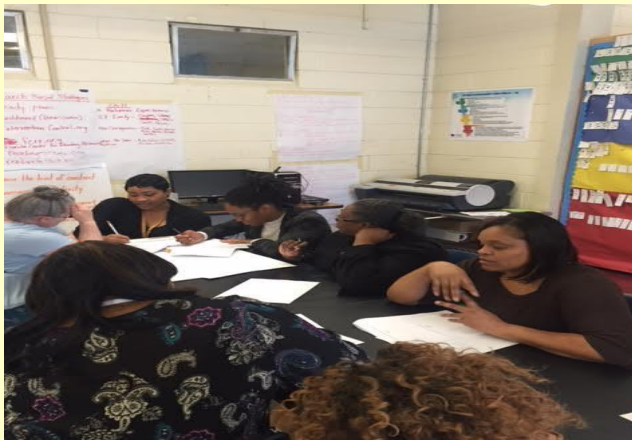
